

Class Rates

Our dance season includes 35 weeks of class, dress rehearsal and the annual recital. The 2018-19 season begins on Monday, August 20 and follows the Union County School Calendar in regards to holiday and inclement weather closings. If a class is cancelled due to inclement weather, a makeup class will be scheduled to ensure each class meets for at least 35 sessions. Tuition prices are calculated on an annual basis and are pro-rated when students join after the first class of the season. Tuition paid in advance for the year will be discounted 10%. Most choose, however, to utilize our tuition installment plan, which is further described below.

Multi-class discounts are calculated per family. For instance, if you have one child taking two classes, the rate is \$840 for the year. If you have two children who each take one class, the rate is still \$840 for the year. Thanks to the generous efforts of our dance community, we do have 25% and 50% scholarships available. Annual Tuition:

30 minute class: \$250 per year for 30 minutes per week

45 minute class: \$375 per year for 45 minutes per week

1 Hour Long Class Per Week: \$480 (\$13.71 per class)

2 Classes Per Week: \$840 (\$12.00 per class)

3 Classes Per Week: \$1120 (\$9.71 per class)

4 Classes Per Week: \$1290 (\$8.92 per class)

5 Classes Per Week: \$1620 (\$8.74 per class)

6 Classes Per Week: \$1785 (\$8.50 per class)

7 Classes Per Week: \$2021.25 (\$8.25 per class)

8 or more Classes Per Week: \$2240 (\$8.00 or less per class)

Add-on Classes: These are specialized technique and conditioning classes designed to supplement our regular dance classes. These are available for an additional \$15 a month and are not part of the annual tuition pricing packages, as they are less expensive than our regular classes.

We accept cash, checks or credit cards. For those on the tuition installment plan, 15% of the annual tuition is due at registration, 10% is due the first class of each month from September-April, and 5% is due in May. For those who choose to pay the year in advance and take advantage of the 10% discount, full tuition is due at registration. Unlike a gym membership, if a student signs up and decides not to continue, they are not contracted to continue paying for the remainder of the season. Of course, we hope that all our dancers stay the full year, but we understand that sometimes interests change!
